Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the 19th meeting between the Chillicothe Cavaliers and the Logan Chieftains. The two teams met for the first time in 1990, and the very competitive series sees Chillicothe with a narrow 10-8 advantage. The Ross Countians have won five of the past seven meetings.

Chillicothe is one of the areas top teams, entering 3-1 overall and coming off a dominating 42-12 victory over Waverly. The Cavaliers lone setback came in a 17-14 loss to Westerville North after opening with wins over Teays Valley (29-19) and London (27-24). The Cavaliers expect to compete for a championship in the Frontier Athletic Conference.

Logan broke into the win column last week with a narrow 17-14 victory over Warren. For the third straight week the Chiefs were tied 7-7 at halftime, and despite a late game fumble near the Warren goal line, escaped with the victory. Logan opened with losses to Jackson (35-8), Teays Valley (17-7), and Sheridan (28-7).

- **Chieftains 110** This fall, Logan will celebrate the 110th anniversary of their first football season in 1912. The school will hold a Celebration of Champions on September 16, welcoming back anniversary championship teams from 1952, 1977, 1987, 1992, and 2007.

Logan has won 578 games, 26 SEOAL championships, and made nine playoff appearances. LoganFootball.com will be writing a long form story on the 1952 champions for their 70th anniversary, has prepared a pregame video for the video board featuring footage from as early as 1950, and will be compiling a list of the 110 greatest players in school history.

- **Stout defense emerges** The Chillicothe run defense found its footing Friday night against one of the top rushing attacks in southeastern Ohio. The Cavaliers (3-1) entered their Week 4 contest at Waverly having allowed 225 yards per game. The Tigers' running game was at a 280 yards per game average and headlined by Jase Hurd's 214 yards per contest clip. - **Celebration of Champions** Tonight, Logan High School welcomes back five Southeastern Ohio Athletic League championship teams celebrating anniversary seasons. Celebrating milestones tonight are teams from 1952 (Finished 6-1-1 70 years ago), 1977 (Finished 10-0 45 years ago), 1987 (Finished 9-2 35 years ago), 1992 (Finished 6-4 30 years ago), and 2007 (Finished 9-2 15 years ago). Coaches and players from these teams will be recognized during tonight's pregame festivities.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Senior halfback *Varik Fick* ran for 242 yards and two scores on 20 carries in last week's win over Warren. Guards *Dalton Brooks* and *Avery Linton* helped open holes for the junior.

Defensively, junior linebacker *Jack Brown* leads the Chieftains with 32 total tackles while senior cornerback *Easton Castle* adds 30 stops, two interceptions, and has broken up four passes. Senior defensive back *Brayden Sturgell* has made 21 stops (in three games) and made an interception last week against Warren.

- **Who to watch: Chillicothe** Junior tight end *Tayvion Galloway* leads the Cavaliers with 15 catches for 285 yards and four touchdowns and has already committed to play football at Louisiana State University after his high school career ends. Quarterback *Mason Doughty* has completed 48 of 85 passes for 643 yards with seven touchdowns and only one interception.

Defensively, senior linebacker *Max Lee* stands out for his ability to find the football and make crunching tackles. Sophomore cornerback Shawn Smith has come up with key tackles and interceptions for the Cavaliers so far in 2022.

- **White lids...** The Chieftains are wearing white helmets this season for the first time since 1985. Logan only wore white in the post leather helmet era until switching to purple in 1986 but have brought back the white lids thanks to a campaign led by former Chieftains from the 1970s. The spear on the side of the helmet has been worn as far back as 1970 and consistently since that same 1986 season.
- **Captains** Logan's 2022 captains are seniors Dalton Brooks, Varik Fick, Brayden Sturgell, and Izaac Swope. Sturgell follows his uncle Josh, a current LHMS coach, who was an LHS football captain in 2003.
- **On this date** Tonight will be the 13th game ever played by LHS on Sept. 16 with the Chieftains holding a 5-6-1 record on this date. They first played on this date in 1938, an 18-6 win over Bremen and most recently lost at Cambridge by a 48-14 score in 2016. The 1977 Chiefs, who return to be honored for their 10-0 season tonight, defeated Hilliard 21-6 on this date in 1977.
