Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the 34th meeting between the Warren Warriors and the Logan Chieftains, but just the third meeting outside of SEOAL play. The longtime league rivals played the final SEOAL football game in 2016. It's also Homecoming at LHS, a tradition that dates back to the early 1930s.

Warren dominated county rival Belpre in a 62-0 season opening victory and lost a heartbreaking 28-24 decision to Morgan. Last week Warren was overmatched by Williamstown (WV), 55-10, a team that expects to compete for a West Virginia state championship.

Logan is winless following losses to Jackson (35-8), Teays Valley (17-7), and Sheridan (28-7). Logan has let back-to-back 7-7 halftime ties slip to defeats over the past two contests. The Chieftains lost starting quarterback Wyatt Woodgeard to a season ending injury last week.

- **Chieftains 110** This fall, Logan will celebrate the 110th anniversary of their first football season in 1912. The school will hold a Celebration of Champions on September 16, welcoming back anniversary championship teams from 1952, 1977, 1987, 1992, and 2007.

Logan has won 577 games, 26 SEOAL championships, and made nine playoff appearances. LoganFootball.com will be writing a long form story on the 1952 champions for their 70th anniversary, has prepared a pregame video for the video board featuring footage from as early as 1950, and will be compiling a list of the 110 greatest players in school history.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Halfback *Varik Fick* leads Logan with 257 yards and a touchdown on 41 carries while senior *Brayden Sturgell* adds 89 yards on 13 carries (in two games) and will lineup all over the field including halfback, quarterback, and split end. Guard *Dalton Brooks* is a key cog in Logan's wing-t attack.

Defensively, senior cornerback *Easton Castle* made a pair of interceptions last week while senior linebacker *Tyler Dawson* made 11 stops and *Sturgell* had 10 tackles. Senior *Ryan Harden* made seven total tackles including two for loss against Sheridan last week.

- **Who to watch: Warren** *Trent Taylor* has completed 37 of 76 passes for 400 yards with three touchdowns and three interceptions for the blue and white. Junior classmate *Jason Williams* adds 226 yards and two scores on just 23 attempts while freshman Tanner Pepper leads the team with 13 catches for 223 yards and a touchdown.

Defensively Warren is led by senior linebacker *Taylor Bowers* who is averaging 10 stops per game and sophomore safety *Jacob Sealey* who averages eight tackles and has also returned a fumble for touchdown and made an interception.

- **Captains** Logan's 2022 captains are seniors Dalton Brooks, Varik Fick, Brayden Sturgell, and Izaac Swope. Sturgell follows his uncle Josh, a current LHMS coach, who was an LHS football captain in 2003.
- **On this date** Tonight, will be the tenth game ever played by LHS on Sept. 9 with the Chieftains holding a 3-6 record on this date. They opened the season on this date in 1960, 1966, and 1977 and most recently played on Sept. 9 in 2016. The 1977 Chiefs finished a perfect 10-0.
