## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the second meeting between the Fort Frye Cadets and the Logan Chieftains. The Cadets completely dominated Logan last season in a 49-14 victory at Fort Frye. In that game, Fort Frye held Logan to (-27) rushing yards, the fourth worst output in school history.

**Fort Frye** is off to another outstanding season and expects to compete for the Division VI state championship. Their lone blemish came in a 41-38 loss to the Linsley School of Wheeling, WV. Outside of that loss, FF has dominated in their seven victories including wins over traditional power programs Bellaire (62-26), Zanesville (40-27), Point Pleasant, WV (44-0), and Caldwell (44-7).

**Logan** dropped a heartbreaking 29-28 decision at Buckeye Valley last Friday. Logan took their first lead late in the fourth quarter 28-21, but the Barons scored with less than 30 seconds to play and converted on a two-point conversion attempt to earn the victory. Logan previously had won three of four games defeating Warren (17-14), Athens (35-13), and St. Charles (21-20) with the loss coming to Chillicothe (0-24).

- **Chieftains 110 ....** This fall, Logan will celebrate the 110<sup>th</sup> anniversary of their first football season in 1912. The school will hold a Celebration of Champions on September 16, welcoming back anniversary championship teams from 1952, 1977, 1987, 1992, and 2007.

Logan has won 580 games, 26 SEOAL championships, and made nine playoff appearances. LoganFootball.com will be writing a long form story on the 1952 champions for their 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary, has prepared a pregame video for the video board featuring footage from as early as 1950, and will be compiling a list of the 110 greatest players in school history.

- **Who to watch: Logan ....** Senior halfback *Varik Fick* is the Chieftains leading rusher with 842 yards and seven touchdowns on 126 carries, but sophomore wingback *Kaden Morgan* has come on strong in the last 4 weeks to total 380 yards and four touchdowns on 60 carries on the season. Senior *Brayden Sturgell* will be used as a situational quarterback in wildcat sets and has run for 189 yards on 34 carries and a touchdown so far this season.

Defensively, junior linebacker *Jack Brown* leads LHS with 66 stops including six for loss and two sacks while senior end *Ryan Harden* adds 56 tackles and six for loss with three sacks. Sophomore *Kallen Wilson* co-leads the team with three sacks. Senior cornerback *Easton Castle* hopes to return from injury and leads the team with six pass break-ups and three interceptions.

- **Who to watch: Fort Frye ....** Senior running back *Owen Brown* leads the Cadets wing-t offense with 1019 yards and 15 touchdowns on just 91 carries while adding 122 yards and three more scores on nine receptions. Senior receiver *Braxton Brown* leads the team with 15 catches for 217 yards and 4 scores. Junior *Graham Baker* anchors a quick and powerful offensive line.

Defensively, linebacker *Zaiden Huck* leads the Washington Countians with 99 tackles including 13 for loss and two sacks. *Braxton Brown* is outstanding from his cornerback post, tallying 13 pass break-ups and making six interceptions. *Baker* and fellow end *Caleb Riggs* both have made eight quarterback sacks.

- **Senior Night, Senior walk ....** Tonight, 16 Chieftain seniors will play their final home game and make the traditional “Senior Walk” across the turf at Logan Chieftain Stadium. This group of seniors are the first class to play an entire career for fourth year Chieftain mentor Mike Eddy.
- **White lids...** The Chieftains are wearing white helmets this season for the first time since 1985. Logan only wore white in the post leather helmet era until switching to purple in 1986 but have brought back the white lids thanks to a campaign led by former Chieftains from the 1970s. The spear on the side of the helmet has been worn as far back as 1970 and consistently since that same 1986 season.
- **Captains ....** Logan’s 2022 captains are seniors Dalton Brooks, Varik Fick, Brayden Sturgell, and Izaac Swope. Sturgell follows his uncle Josh, a current LHMS coach, who was an LHS football captain in 2003.
- **On this date ....** Tonight, will be the 17<sup>th</sup> game ever played by LHS on October 14 with the Chieftains holding a 9-5-2 record on this date. They first played on this date in 1920, a 21-0 win over Lancaster St. Marys and most recently lost to St. Francis DeSales 7-54 in 2016.
