Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the 99th meeting between Logan and Jackson – or the 100th if you're from Jackson. A game between the towns was played in 1906 (a Jackson victory) – and is counted as an official game by JHS but pre-dates Logan's official records. The Ironmen hold a narrow lead in the all-time series – 48-46-4 – thanks to their current six game winning streak. That streak matches the longest ever by the Ironmen against Logan.

Jackson is coming off another fine season where they finished 10-3 and as the regional runner-up in Division III, Reg. 11 and champions of the Frontier Athletic Conference. Their only losses came to Ironton (10-13) and twice to Western Brown by nearly identical 28-33 and 28-35 scores.

Logan finished the 2021 season 2-7 overall with wins over archrival Athens and former SEOAL foe Meigs. Five of their seven losses came to playoff qualifier.

- **Chieftains 110** This fall, Logan will celebrate the 110th anniversary of their first football season in 1912. The school will hold a Celebration of Champions on September 16, welcoming back anniversary championship teams from 1952, 1977, 1987, 1992, and 2007.

Logan has won 577 games, 26 SEOAL championships, and made nine playoff appearances. LoganFootball.com will be writing a long form story on the 1952 champions for their 70th anniversary, has prepared a pregame video for the video board featuring footage from as early as 1950, and will be compiling a list of the 110 greatest players in school history.

- **Opening night jinx** Over the last 21 seasons the Chieftains are a dismal 4-17 in season openers. On the bright side, three of those four season opening wins ended in perfect 10-0 regular seasons.

Logan defeated New Lexington 13-12 in 2001, Lancaster in 2008 (35-10) and 2009 (33-14) and beat Athens 62-49 in 2015. In between those victories were lone losses to New Lex and Westerville South; nine losses to Lancaster; and two each against Dublin Jerome, Tri-Valley, and Jackson.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Offensively, Logan will shift from a spread wing-to a more traditional wing-t offense, relying on the legs of senior halfback *Brayden Sturgell*. Up front, center *Anthony McCune*, guards *Kallen Wilson* and *Dalton Brooks*, and tackle *Connor Carrier* are returning starters.

Defensively Logan must improve on a disappointing 2021 campaign. At linebacker *Jack Brown* and *Tyler Dawson* are returning starters and *Sturgell* can play almost any position. The defensive line will be inexperienced but the secondary returns a pair of starters.

- **Who to watch: Jackson** The Welsh offense revolves around the skill of Ohio University-bound senior quarterback *Jacob Winters* and versatile running back-slot *Cade Wolford*. They operate out of spread shotgun and under center power run-heavy offense.

Defensively *AJ Denny* is disruptive on the defensive line and linebacker *Andrew Davis* is a reliable focal point. *Winters* and *Wolford* can play all over the secondary and *Jacob Wood* can cover and provide run support from his cornerback post.

- **Captains** Logan's 2022 captains are seniors Dalton Brooks, Varik Fick, Brayden Sturgell, and Izaac Swope. Sturgell follows his uncle Josh, a current LHMS coach, who was an LHS football captain in 2003.
- **Common foe** Jackson and Logan are longtime rivals, meeting 98 times on the gridiron since 1912. The two teams also met in 1906 (a Jackson victory) prior to official LHS records. Jackson leads the all-time series 48-46-4 and the overall score is separated by just 28 points. Both schools were founding members of the SEOAL with Logan winning a record 26 titles and Jackson winning 25.

Jackson, currently riding a six-game winning streak over Logan, has equaled their longest winning streak over the purple and white. They previously won 6 straight meetings between 1926-1932.

- **On this date** Tonight will match the earliest opener in school history and the second game ever played on Aug. 19. These two teams met exactly one year ago with JHS prevailing 42-7. The previous earliest start dates came on Aug. 22 in both 2003 (0-29 loss at Westerville South) and 2008 (35-10 win over Lancaster).
