Game Notes:

- Tonight's Match-up... Tonight is the 2nd meeting between the St. Charles Prep Cardinals and the Logan Chieftains since LHS official records began in 1912. St. Charles defeated Logan 27-0 last year in Logan Chieftain Stadium.
 - **St. Charles** is the only all-male high school in the Columbus diocese and their rigorous academic standards make it one of the most respected schools in Ohio. The Cardinals are 3-3 this season with wins over Northland (48-28), winless Amanda-Clearcreek (35-0), and KIPP Columbus (57-36). Their three defeats came to Delaware-Hayes (0-17), Washington Courthouse (21-50), and Bishop Watterson (0-42) who are a combined 15-3 this season.

Logan has won two of their last three games after an 0-3 start and defeated rival Athens 35-13 last week. The Chieftains defeated former league rival Warren 17-14 in week four with a 24-0 loss to Chillicothe sandwiched in between. Logan opened with losses to Jackson (8-35), Teays Valley (7-17), and Sheridan (7-28). Logan's four losses came against opponents who sit a combined 17-7 overall.

- Chieftains 110 This fall, Logan will celebrate the 110th anniversary of their first football season in 1912. The school will hold a Celebration of Champions on September 16, welcoming back anniversary championship teams from 1952, 1977, 1987, 1992, and 2007.

Logan has won 578 games, 26 SEOAL championships, and made nine playoff appearances. LoganFootball.com will be writing a long form story on the 1952 champions for their 70th anniversary, has prepared a pregame video for the video board featuring footage from as early as 1950, and will be compiling a list of the 110 greatest players in school history.

- Who to watch: Logan Senior halfback *Varik Fick* is the Chieftains leading rusher with 705 yards and six touchdowns on 96 carries. Senior *Brayden Sturgell* will play all over the field, taking direct snaps out of the shotgun, as a split end, and even as a halfback. Logan also got key production from halfback *Kaden Morgan* (11-64, TD) and fullback *Chris Gompf* (14-61). Guard *Dalton Brooks* is key on Logan's offensive line.

Defensively, junior linebacker *Jack Brown* leads LHS with 49 stops including four for loss while senior end *Ryan Harden* is right behind with 48 and four for loss. Cornerback *Easton Castle* has made 45 stops and made a team high six pass breakups and intercepted a team leading three passes.

- Who to watch: St. Charles Senior tackle *Ryan Caretta* anchors a physical offensive line and has verbally committed to play football at the University of Pittsburgh next fall. Running backs *Pete DeSocio* and *Mason O'Reilly* are both capable of grinding out yardage or breaking long runs.

Defensively linebackers *Ryan Greenhalge*, *DeSocio*, and *O'Reilly* are veterans with *Carretta* and *Austin Fraley* leading the defensiveline. *Colin Greenhalge* plays a hybrid safety-linebacker position.

- Logan against the Diocese This will be Logan's 30th game against a school from the Catholic Diocese of Columbus. The Chieftains hold a 15-13-1 overall record in games played against Aquinas College High School (3-2 record), Father Wherle (2-2), Columbus St. Mary's (2-0), Lancaster St. Mary's (5-0-1), St. Francis DeSales (3-7), Bishop Watterson (0-1), and St. Charles (0-1). Logan has lost their last six games against central Ohio Catholic competition.
- White lids... The Chieftains are wearing white helmets this season for the first time since 1985. Logan only wore white in the post leather helmet era until switching to purple in 1986 but have brought back the white lids thanks to a campaign led by former Chieftains from the 1970s. The spear on the side of the helmet has been worn as far back as 1970 and consistently since that same 1986 season.
- Captains Logan's 2022 captains are seniors Dalton Brooks, Varik Fick, Brayden Sturgell, and Izaac Swope. Sturgell follows his uncle Josh, a current LHMS coach, who was an LHS football captain in 2003.
- On this date Tonight, will be the 15th game ever played by LHS on Sept. 30 with the Chieftains holding a 11-2-1 record on this date. They first played on this date in 1921, a 40-0 win over Bremen in a game played at the Hocking County Fairgrounds and most recently defeated rival Athens 31-30 in 2016. Logan won their only game of the 2011 season on this date, defeating current head coach Mike Eddy's Gallipolis Blue Devils 14-3.
