## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the fifth meeting between the Logan Chieftains and the Sheridan Generals. The two schools met for many years in their final tune up scrimmage, and first played a regular season game in 2017. The two teams have met every season since except for a cancellation in 2020 due to the COVID-19 public health crisis. The Generals have won all four meetings.

**Sheridan** has split a pair of high scoring shootouts so far this season, topping Licking Valley 35-28 and falling to Watkins Memorial 27-24. The Generals are well coached, disciplined, and physical while also doing an excellent job of playing in space.

**Logan** committed two ill-timed turnovers in the fourth quarter of a 17-7 loss to Teays Valley last week. The teams were tied at 7 as the fourth quarter began and Logan lost fumbles on their next two offensive plays and the Vikings capitalized to take a two-score lead. Logan allowed too many big plays in their season opening 35-8 loss to Jackson.

- **Chieftains 110 ....** This fall, Logan will celebrate the 110<sup>th</sup> anniversary of their first football season in 1912. The school will hold a Celebration of Champions on September 16, welcoming back anniversary championship teams from 1952, 1977, 1987, 1992, and 2007.

Logan has won 577 games, 26 SEOAL championships, and made nine playoff appearances. LoganFootball.com will be writing a long form story on the 1952 champions for their 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary, has prepared a pregame video for the video board featuring footage from as early as 1950, and will be compiling a list of the 110 greatest players in school history.

- **Who to watch: Logan ....** *Varik Fick* stepped into Logan's weak side half back role to run for 125 yards and a score on 15 carries and caught a single pass for another 30 yards. Up front, *Dalton Brooks* is a key blocker at right guard in Logan's wing-t offense.

Defensively, junior linebacker *Jack Brown* recorded 18 tackles last week – including four for loss in a career best outing. Cornerback *Easton Castle* made 10 stops and broke up a pair of passes. Opposite corner *Izaac Swope* made an interception and a fumble recovery.

- **Who to watch: Sheridan ....** *Reid Packer* has completed 15 of 28 passes for 241 yards and three touchdowns against a single interception while *Alex Poirier* has rushed for 139 yards and three scores on 31 carries. *Andrew Holden* leads the team with eight receptions for 137 yards and a pair of scores.

Defensively Sheridan is allowing just over 350 yards per game in their 3-3 stack base defense. *Reece Hale* is stout at the noseguard position while *Chase Elson* plays downhill from the middle linebacker position. *Packer* is a standout at free safety where he makes excellent open field tackles and also acts as a center fielder on passing downs.

- **Captains ....** Logan's 2022 captains are seniors Dalton Brooks, Varik Fick, Brayden Sturgell, and Izaac Swope. Sturgell follows his uncle Josh, a current LHMS coach, who was an LHS football captain in 2003.
- **On this date ....** Tonight, will be the seventh game ever played by LHS on Sept. 2 with the Chieftains holding a 3-3 record on this date. They first played on Sept. 2 in 1983, a season opening loss at New Lexington. Logan's largest win on September 2 was a 45-0 win over Nelsonville-York in 1988 and their largest loss was a 42-14 defeat to Pickerington North in 2011.
