## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the tenth meeting between the Logan Chieftains and the Teays Valley Vikings. The two schools, who have met every season since 2013, will both join the Ohio Capital Conference and become league rivals in 2024. The Viking lead the series 7-2 and trounced Logan 49-6 last season in Ashville.

**Teays Valley** couldn't overcome mistakes and big plays in their 19-29 loss to Chillicothe last week. The Vikings committed five turnovers and had a poor punt snap cost them field position. Harrison Payne caught 12 passes for 182 yards and a touchdown while Gavin Karshner ran for 131 yards and two touchdowns.

**Logan** allowed Jackson's dynamic duo of Ohio University-bound quarterback Jacob Winters and running back Cade Wolford to combine for five touchdowns and loads of big plays in the 35-8 Ironmen victory at Logan. Logan's offense struggle to finish drives and their lone touchdown came on a special team's miscue by Jackson.

- **Chieftains 110 ....** This fall, Logan will celebrate the 110<sup>th</sup> anniversary of their first football season in 1912. The school will hold a Celebration of Champions on September 16, welcoming back anniversary championship teams from 1952, 1977, 1987, 1992, and 2007.

Logan has won 577 games, 26 SEOAL championships, and made nine playoff appearances. LoganFootball.com will be writing a long form story on the 1952 champions for their 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary, has prepared a pregame video for the video board featuring footage from as early as 1950, and will be compiling a list of the 110 greatest players in school history.

- **Who to watch: Logan ....** Logan's offense struggled to finish drives as they saw three possessions end on downs inside the redzone. Guard *Dalton Brooks* made a difference in the second half opening running lanes for *Brayden Sturgell* and *Varik Fick*. Sturgell will miss tonight's game with a lingering injury.

Defensively Logan must improve on a disappointing 2021 campaign. At linebacker *Jack Brown* and *Tyler Dawson* are returning starters and OLB *Dalton Brooks* recorded four tackles in only 14 snaps last week. *Easton Castle* made some key stops from his cornerback post.

- **Who to watch: Teays Valley ....** Teays Valley will try to be the more physical football team on both sides of the ball behind seniors tackle *Joey Thurston* and guard *Mike Black*. *Gavin Karshner* is a battering ram at running back who gained 131 yards and scored twice last week while the speedy *Richard Odum* added 117 yards on the ground. *Harrison Payne* caught 12 passes for 182 yards and a score and is a big play threat.

Defensively TV held Chillicothe to just 118 yards rushing and under 300 yards of total offense but were bit by big plays. *Parker Baisden* is talented and disciplined at his outside linebacker spot while *River Rigsby* anchors one side of the defensive line from his end position. *Karshner* and *Hayden Wells* feature at inside linebacker.

- **Captains ....** Logan's 2022 captains are seniors Dalton Brooks, Varik Fick, Brayden Sturgell, and Izaac Swope. Sturgell follows his uncle Josh, a current LHMS coach, who was an LHS football captain in 2003.
- **On this date ....** Tonight, will be just the fourth game ever played by LHS on August 26<sup>th</sup>, with the Chieftains holding an 0-3 record on this date. They first played on Aug. 26 back in 2005, a 7-0 loss at Lancaster.
