Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight Logan and Warren meet for the 35th time in a series that began when the Warriors joined the old Southeastern Ohio Athletic League in 1986. The two teams were league rivals until 2016 when they played the final SEOAL football contest. Logan leads the all-time series 28-6 and won last season 17-14.

Warren finished 4-6 last fall but expect to be in playoff contention in the newly expanded playoffs this season. They opened with a 66-6 win over archrival Belpre but have lost the last two weeks to Morgan (22-33) and Fairfield Union (3-42).

Logan finished the 2022 season with a 4-6 record and was a two-point conversion stop at Buckeye Valley away from their first .500 season since the team finished 8-2 in 2015. Logan has started the season 0-3 with losses at Jackson (0-22), Teays Valley (6-28), and Sheridan (10-41).

- **In memory of CD** This season, the Chieftains are wearing special decals on their helmets in memory of longtime Logan sportswriter and Chieftain supporter, Craig Dunn. The decals are a silhouette of Craig's trademark purple hat with the initials "CD" inside. Craig was a 1977 graduate of Logan High School and began covering sports for the Logan Daily News – and later the Logan-Hocking Times – while he was still in high school. Craig passed away suddenly this past spring.
- **Looking for 600** Logan enters tonight with 591 wins in program history and an overall record of 591-432-37. They first played football in 1905. In their history they have also won 26 league championships, qualified for the OHSAA playoffs nine times, and finished with perfect 10-0 regular season records seven times.
- **Who to watch: Logan** For the first time in school history, Logan started freshman *Carson Tootle* at quarterback last week against Sheridan. While he completed just 4 of 18 passes for 94 yards, on Logan's touchdown drive, he connected twice with junior *Jack Walsh* for 44 and 27 yards with the junior making a pair of outstanding catches. *Kaden Morgan* is the team's leading rusher and *Kallen Wilson* anchors the offensive line.

Logan was a mixed bag defensively. They held a powerful Sheridan running game in check but were torched through the aerial route allowing 154 yards and three touchdowns. *Jack Brown* led Logan with seven tackles. Cornerback *Talon Thompson* added six stops and linebacker *Kaden Morgan* five.

- **Who to watch: Warren....** The Warriors are balanced offensively, running for 455 yards and passing for 550 on the season. Quarterback *Jacob Sealey* is a key cog running for 166 and three touchdowns while throwing for 550 and four scores. *Eric Carr* is the leading rusher with 284 yards and four touchdowns. *Tanner Pepper* is a deep ball threat hauling in 23 catches for 307 yards and two scores.

Defensively, Warren is yielding nearly 300 yards and 27 points per game. Operating out of 5-2 base defense, *Aden Strahler* and *Eugene Pahl III* anchor the defensive line. Cornerback *Nick Cressley* tied the career school record for interceptions last week as he pilfered his 11th aerial.

- **Ohio Capital Conference** Logan has been independent since the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League dissolved following the 2016-17 school year. Logan was a member of the SEOAL, which was founded in 1925, for its entire existence.

Logan will be joining the OCC-Buckeye division along with Canal Winchester, Groveport-Madison, Lancaster, Newark, Pickerington Central, Reynoldsburg, and Teays Valley

- **Captains** Logan's 2023 captains are seniors Jack Brown, Lucas Wolfe, and Wyatt Woodgeard along with juniors Jack Walsh and Kallen Wilson. All but Brown are legacy Chieftains – their fathers all played at LHS.

Walsh and Wilson are just the fifth and sixth underclassmen to serve as captains. Walsh joins his father, Pat, and brothers, Brady and Quinn, who previously served as captains.

- **On this date** Tonight, will be the eighth game ever played by LHS on September 8th with the Chiefs holding a 6-2 record on the date. Logan first played on September 8 in 1961, a 12-8 loss at Bexley. In 1989 Logan defeated Columbus St. Francis DeSales for the first time on this date by a 17-14 score.
