## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight is the 31<sup>st</sup> meeting between Logan and Marietta, but the first between the two old league foes since 2010. Logan leads the all-time series 24-6, including wins in the last eight matchups. The teams met as non-league opponents four times between 1921 and 1951, and then 26 times when both were members of the old Southeastern Ohio Athletic League between 1985 and 2010.

With Logan joining the Ohio Capital Conference in 2024, this is the last scheduled meeting for the foreseeable future.

**Marietta** enters tonight with a 3-3 record and fell in heartbreaking fashion last week against two-time defending West Virginia small school state champion Williamstown, 22-19. The Tigers led 19-7 entering the fourth quarter.

**Logan** enters tonight's game with a 1-5 record. Like the Tigers, Logan wasted a two-score lead in the fourth quarter against their archrival, the Athens Bulldogs. Logan led 21-12 with 6:26 to play but a series of mistakes allowed the Bulldogs to score the game's final 18 points to pull off a stunning 30-21 victory.

- **In memory of CD ....** This season, the Chieftains are wearing special decals on their helmets in memory of longtime Logan sportswriter and Chieftain supporter, Craig Dunn. The decals are a silhouette of Craig's trademark purple hat with the initials "CD" inside. Craig was a 1977 graduate of Logan High School and began covering sports for the Logan Daily News – and later the Logan-Hocking Times – while he was still in high school. Craig passed away suddenly this past spring.
- **Looking for 600 ....** Logan enters tonight with 592 wins in program history and an overall record of 592-434-37. They first played football in 1905. In their history they have also won 26 league championships, qualified for the OHSAA playoffs nine times, and finished with perfect 10-0 regular season records seven times.
- **Homecoming ....** Logan HS celebrates Homecoming festivities tonight. The tradition of a Homecoming game dates back to 1933 when Melrose Harbaugh organized a reunion of former players that has grown into a reunion of all LHS graduates and of course the crowning of the Homecoming Queen.

Tonight's King candidates are Jack Brown, Corbin Dennis, Parker Glenn, Gage Roop, and Noah Swart. The Queen candidates are Delaney Boals, Gabby Mundy, Hannah Nunley, Aislynn Slack, and Kati Strauss.

- **Ohio Capital Conference ....** Logan has been independent since the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League dissolved following the 2016-17 school year. Logan was a member of the SEOAL, which was founded in 1925, for its entire existence.

Logan will be joining the OCC-Buckeye division in 2024-25 along with Canal Winchester, Groveport-Madison, Lancaster, Newark, Pickerington Central, Reynoldsburg, and Teays Valley.

- **Who to watch: Logan ....** Running back *Kaden Morgan* leads LHS with 453 yards and a pair of touchdowns on 100 attempts while also grabbing six aerials for 48 yards. *Carson Tootle* is the first freshman to ever start at quarterback in program history, and has completed 30 of 68 passes for 430 yards with three touchdowns and three interceptions in five starts. *Kallen Wilson* is a key piece of the offensive line as a pulling guard in Logan's wing-t offense.

Senior linebacker *Jack Brown* leads the Chieftains with 47 total tackles including three for loss and a sack to go along with five quarterback pressures. End *Maddox Arnett* adds four tackles for loss and a team high three sacks to go along with 40 total stops. Outside linebacker *Jack Walsh* has made 38 tackles including five for loss and a sack. Safety *Jeremy Fraley* has made a pair of interceptions, broken up two passes, and caused three fumbles.

- **Who to watch: Marietta....** Wingback *Junior Smith* and fullback *Zane Wittekind* provide a true "Mr. Inside-Mr. Outside" dynamic in the Tigers' wing-t offense. *Smith* leads the orange and black with 660 yards and eight touchdowns on 84 attempts while *Wittekind* adds 620 and 10 scores on 89 attempts. *Dylan Dearth* helps anchor an athletic offensive line.

Defensively, ends *Robby Swisher* and *Blake Hanson* lead up front in the Tigers' 4-4 base defense. Inside linebacker *Kobe Alexander* leads the team in tackles. Corner *Carson Chavez* leads the team in pass break-ups and has an interception to his credit. Tackle *Blake Bills* leads the team in tackles for loss.

- **Captains ....** Logan's 2023 captains are seniors Jack Brown, Lucas Wolfe, and Wyatt Woodgeard along with juniors Jack Walsh and Kallen Wilson. All but Brown are legacy Chieftains – their fathers all played at LHS.

Walsh and Wilson are just the fifth and sixth underclassmen to serve as captains. Walsh joins his father, Pat, and brothers, Brady and Quinn, who previously served as captains.

- **On this date ....** Tonight, will be the thirteenth game ever played by LHS on September 29<sup>th</sup> with the Chiefs holding an 8-4-1 record on the date. Logan first played on September 29 in 1928, a 12-0 loss at Lancaster. Logan has played Athens (1967, 2000, and 2017) and Gallipolis (1950, 1972, and 1989) three times each on this date. They are 2-1 against the Bulldogs and 1-1-1 against the Blue Devils
