Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ...** Tonight Logan and Teays Valley will meet for the final time as non-league opponents. The Vikings lead the all-time series, which began in 2013, 8-2. Starting next fall the two schools will be new members of the Ohio Capital Conference (OCC). The teams will meet in week 10. Teays Valley won last season at Logan by scoring 10 unanswered points to pull away for a 17-7 victory.

Teays Valley finished 5-5 last season and just missed a postseason berth in Division II, region 7. The blue and gold were 3-3 against Mid-State League competition in their final season under Coach Mark Weber. Last week, TVHS returned the opening kickoff for a touchdown against Lancaster and led 17-10 entering the fourth quarter. The Gold Gales scored the game's final 14 points to win 24-17.

Logan finished the 2022 season with a 4-6 record and were a two-point conversion stop at Buckeye Valley away from their first .500 season since the team finished 8-2 in 2015. Last week, the Chieftains fell at Jackson 22-0. The Ironmen converted on field goals of 37 and 46 yards and returned a punt 87 yards for a touchdown as their special teams played a major role in the victory.

- **Looking for 600** Logan enters tonight with 591 wins in program history and an overall record of 591-430-37. They first played football in 1905. In their history they have also won 26 league championships, qualified for the OHSAA playoffs nine times, and finished with perfect 10-0 regular season records seven times.
- **Ohio Capital Conference** Logan has been independent since the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League dissolved following the 2016-17 school year. Logan was a member of the SEOAL, which was founded in 1925, for its entire existence.

Teays Valley has been a member of the Mid-State League Buckeye division since 1984 and will be joining Logan in the OCC-Buckeye division along with Canal Winchester, Groveport-Madison, Lancaster, Newark, Pickerington Central, and Reynoldsburg.

- **Who to watch: Logan** Logan struggled offensively last week against a stingy Jackson defense, gaining just 128 yards of total offense and failing to score. Junior running back *Kaden Morgan* led LHS with 41 yards on 14 carries.

Conversely, Logan felt good about its defensive performance, yielding just 13 points and 177 total yards to the Ironmen. *Jack Walsh* led LHS with 10 tackles including a sack and a pass breakup. Linebacker *Kive Rose* recorded a sack and a pair of quarterback pressures.

- **Who to watch: Teays Valley** Teays Valley was balanced offensively in their loss to Lancaster – rushing for 52 yards and passing for 79. Quarterback *Kole Nungester* completed eight passes to star wide receiver *Harrison Payne* and also ran for a 63-yard touchdown on a bootleg.

Defensively, the Vikings were led by linebackers *Jeremiah Fabbro* and *Lane Schooley* in slowing down Lancaster’s power run game. They also intercepted a pair of passes.

- **Captains** Logan’s 2023 captains are seniors Jack Brown, Lucas Wolfe, and Wyatt Woodgeard along with juniors Jack Walsh and Kallen Wilson. All but Brown are legacy Chieftains – their fathers all played at LHS.

Walsh and Wilson are just the fifth and sixth underclassmen to serve as captains. Walsh joins his father, Pat, and brother, Brady, who previously served as captains.

- **On this date** Tonight will be the fifth game ever played by LHS on August 25 with the Chiefs holding a 2-2 record on the date. Logan first played on August 25 in 1989, a 23-6 victory over New Lexington. This will be the first time a game played on August 25 has not been the season opener.
